- Plus your Official transcripts from each college you have previously attended
- Submit your official high school transcript and ACT or SAT scores.*

(If you have completed fewer than 30 college semester hours.)

If you are an International student...

- Mail your completed application, along with a \$135 non refundable application fee.
- Plus your official high school transcript.
- Submit your TOEFL scores

BEFORE YOU GET STARTED

We encourage you to take time with the completion of this application and be candid and thorough in answering the questions provided. Knoxville College admission is competitive. It is important that our admissions committee be as informed as possible to make the appropriate decision. Your academic potential is most important, but your ability to contribute to the talent and diversity of our student body is also of interest to us. We encourage you to submit other information, such as letters of recommendation from teachers and guidance counselors, as well as examples of your creative work. Your ability to demonstrate your interest in Knoxville College is also important to us.

APPLICATION DATE AND DEADLINES

Apply as early as possible and remember that deadlines are important. You may choose any of the options listed on the application; however, **if you are planning to apply for Knoxville College Scholarships, you must apply for admission by January 15.**

EARLY ACTION – NOVEMBER 1 DEADLINE

If you would like to have an early indication of your admissibility to Knoxville College, you should consider applying under our **Early Action** program. **Early Action** applicants are notified of their admission status no later than December 1, and no commitment to enroll is required. Early Applicants are not restricted in any way from applying to other schools.

TRANSCRIPTS

Take the enclosed Transcript Request Form to your guidance counselor to have an official high school transcript attached and set to Knoxville College. Please note that **it is responsibility to request mid-year grades, as soon as they are available, and have them sent to Knoxville College.** If you have taken courses for college credit, please request official transcripts from each college or university attended.

ADMISSION TESTS

Knoxville College requires either the SAT or ACT and will accept test scores recorded on your high school transcript. If you will be taking either test during the 2008-2009 school year, have your scores sent directly to the College (ACT test code – 3972; SAT test code – 1373).
